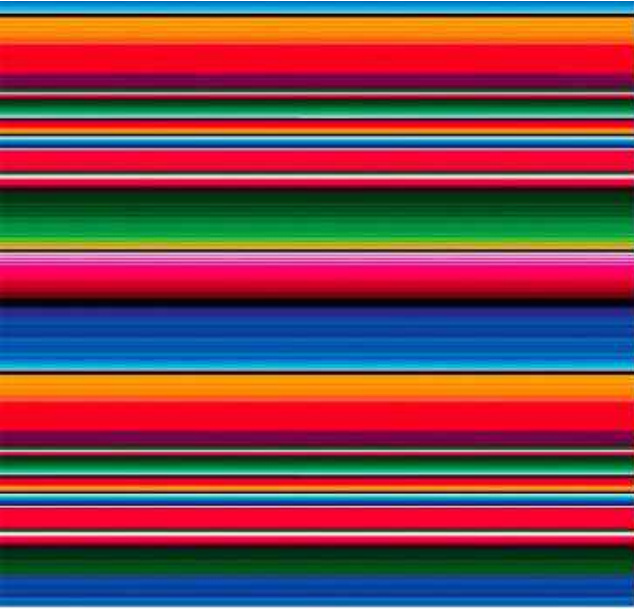

Cinco de Mayo

Cinco de Mayo commemorates Mexico's victory over France at the Battle of Puebla during the Franco-Mexican War in 1862. In Mexico, this is a relatively minor holiday, the state of Puebla often hosts a military parade or recreation of the battle, but it is not a federal holiday. In the mid-20th-century Mexican immigrants used this day to raise awareness identifying it with the victory of Indigenous Mexicans. The United States often misconceives this holiday as Mexican Independence day, which actually is on September 16th. In June of 2005, the United States Congress called for the observance of Cindo de Mayo. Here, Cinco de Mayo is seen a celebration of Mexican culture and heritage and the day is marked with parades, parties, mariachi music, dance and traditional foods. Over fifty percent of Americans will eat Mexican food today, a third will drink a margarita and only twenty percent will celebrate Mexican culture.

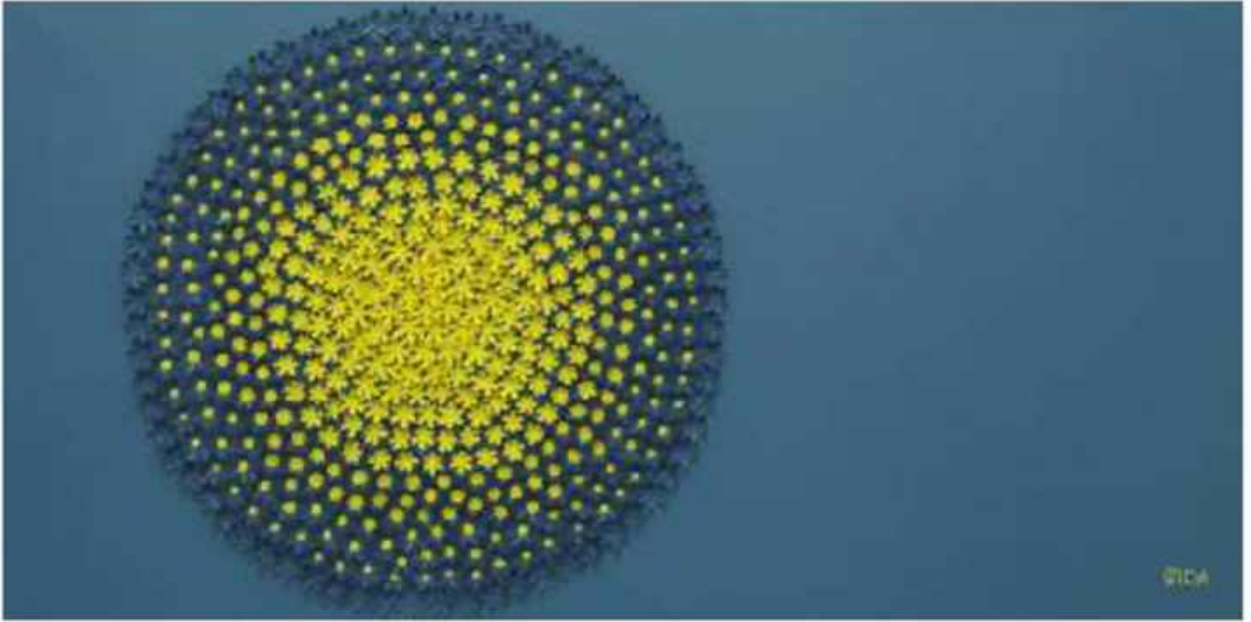

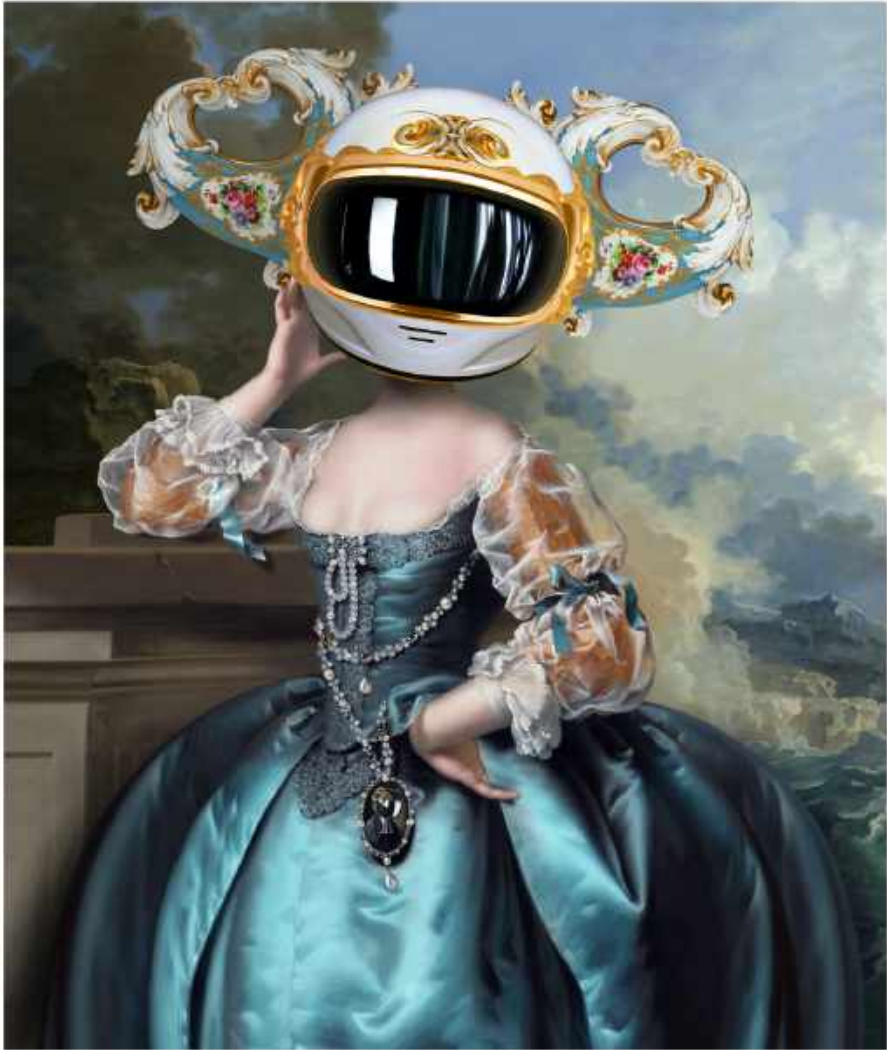
