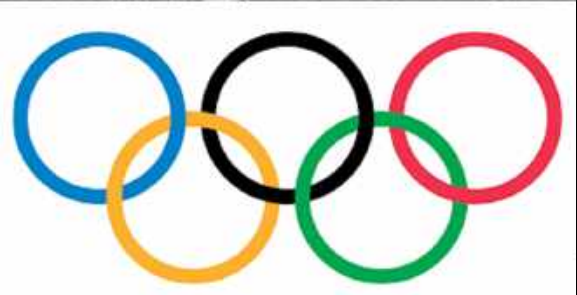

The first Olympic games dated to 776 B.C. and originated in ancient Greece. They were held every four years in Olympia to honor the god Zeus. After a series of Olympiads these games were no longer celebrated. Baron Pierre de Coubertin of France is to thank for bringing this tradition back to light. He was dedicated to the promotion of physical education and created the International Olympic Committee. The modern Olympics took place in 1896 featuring 280 participants from 12 nations in 43 events. In 1924 the Olympics took off as an international sporting event and have been active since with the exception of World War I & II. This year there are 206 countries competing across 33 sports and 339 events. Though when the Olympics started back in the 8th century B.C. it was a male only event, in fact married women spectators were even banned. This year, of nearly 11,000 athletes competing in Tokyo, almost 49 percent are female.

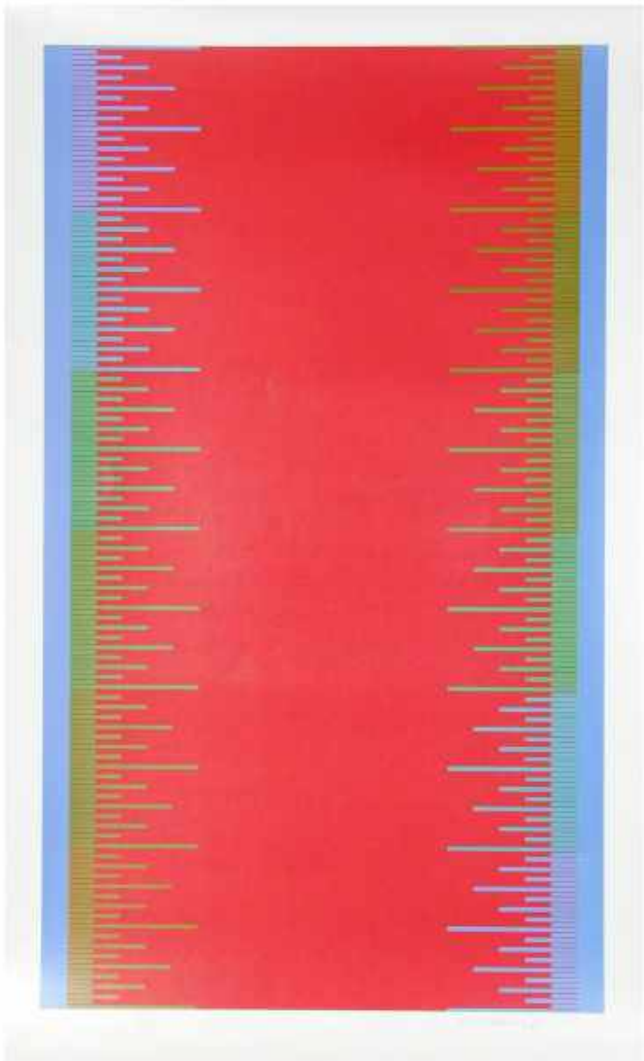

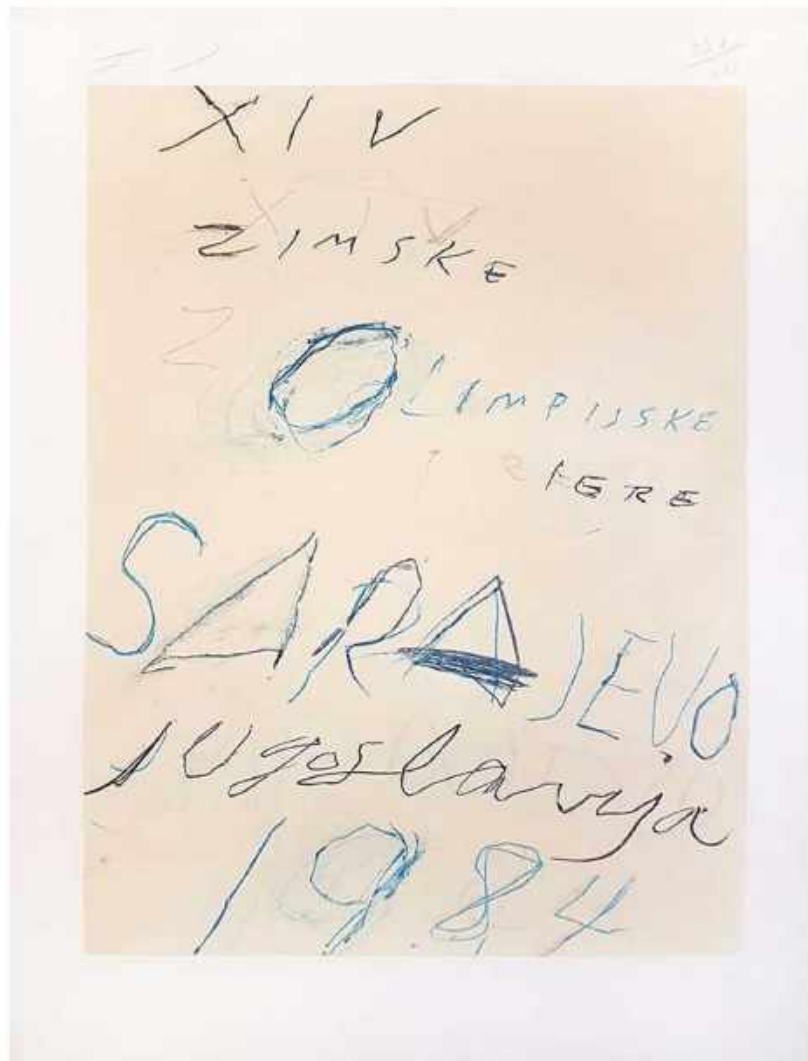
