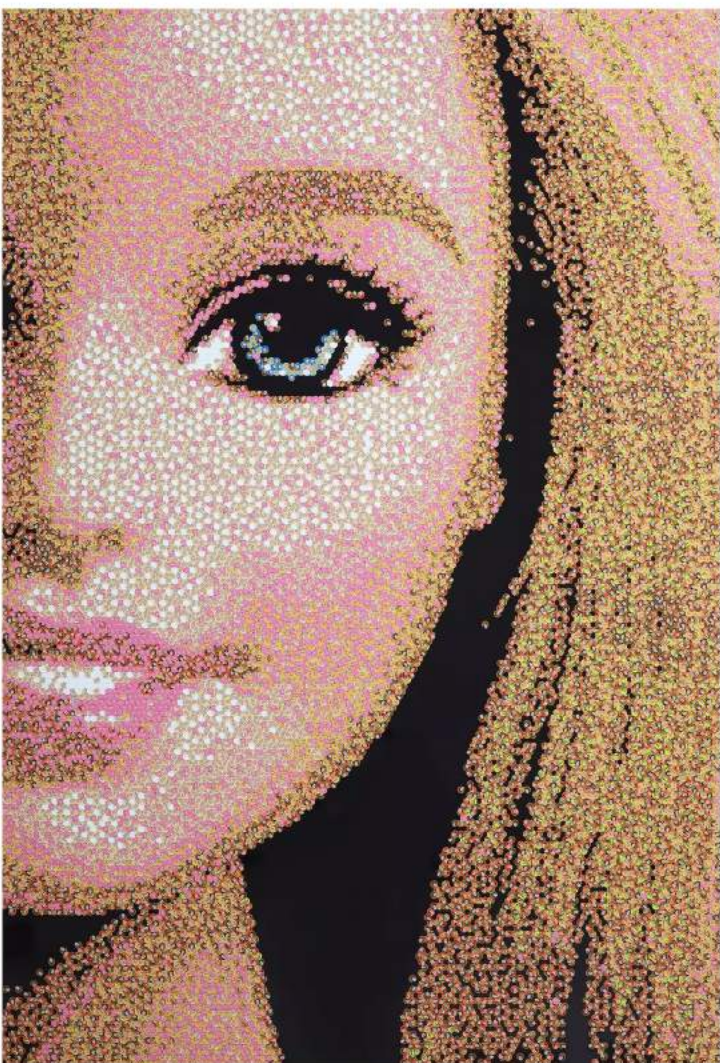

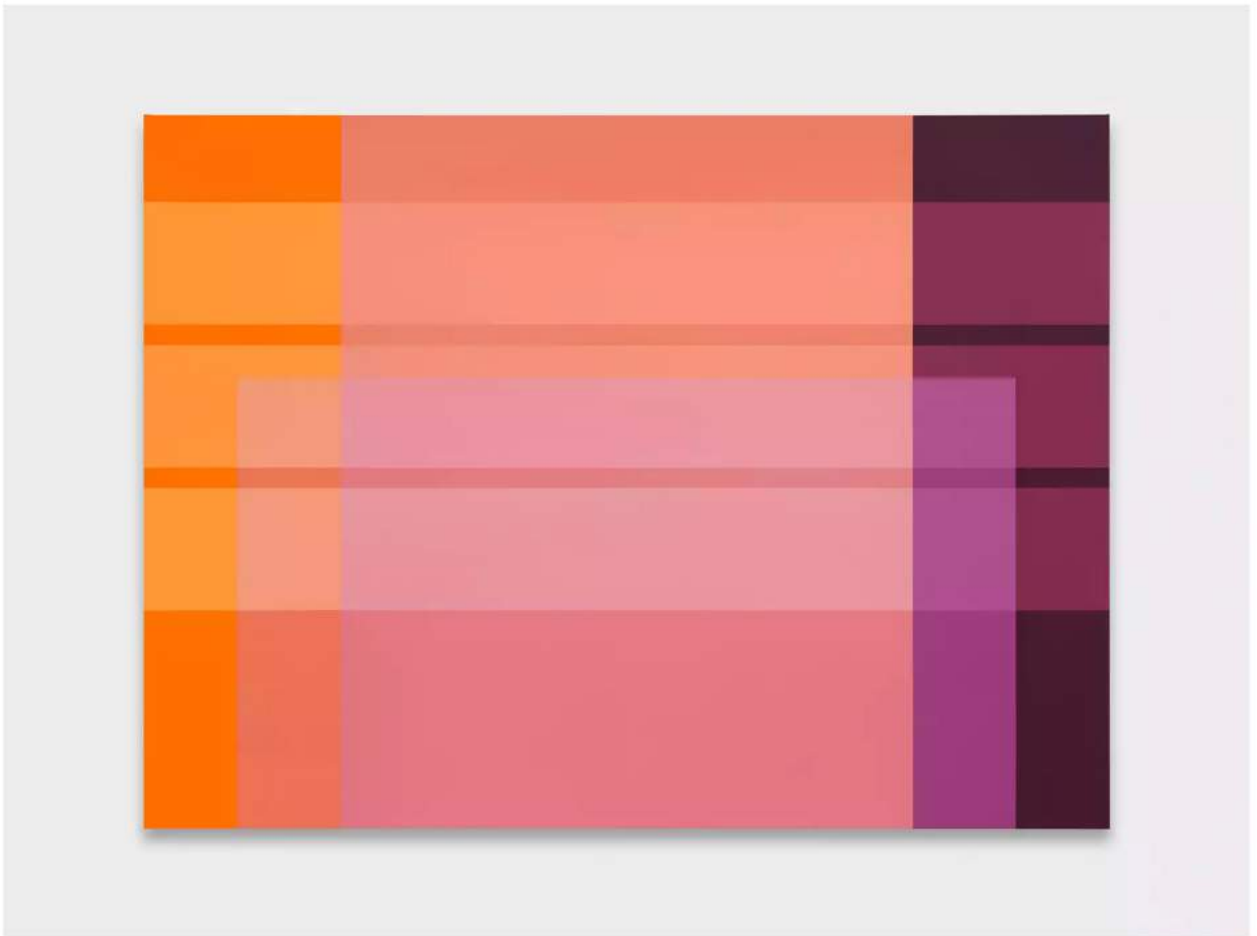

Though this candy-coated film is a comedy it tackles issues such as sexism and self-determination.

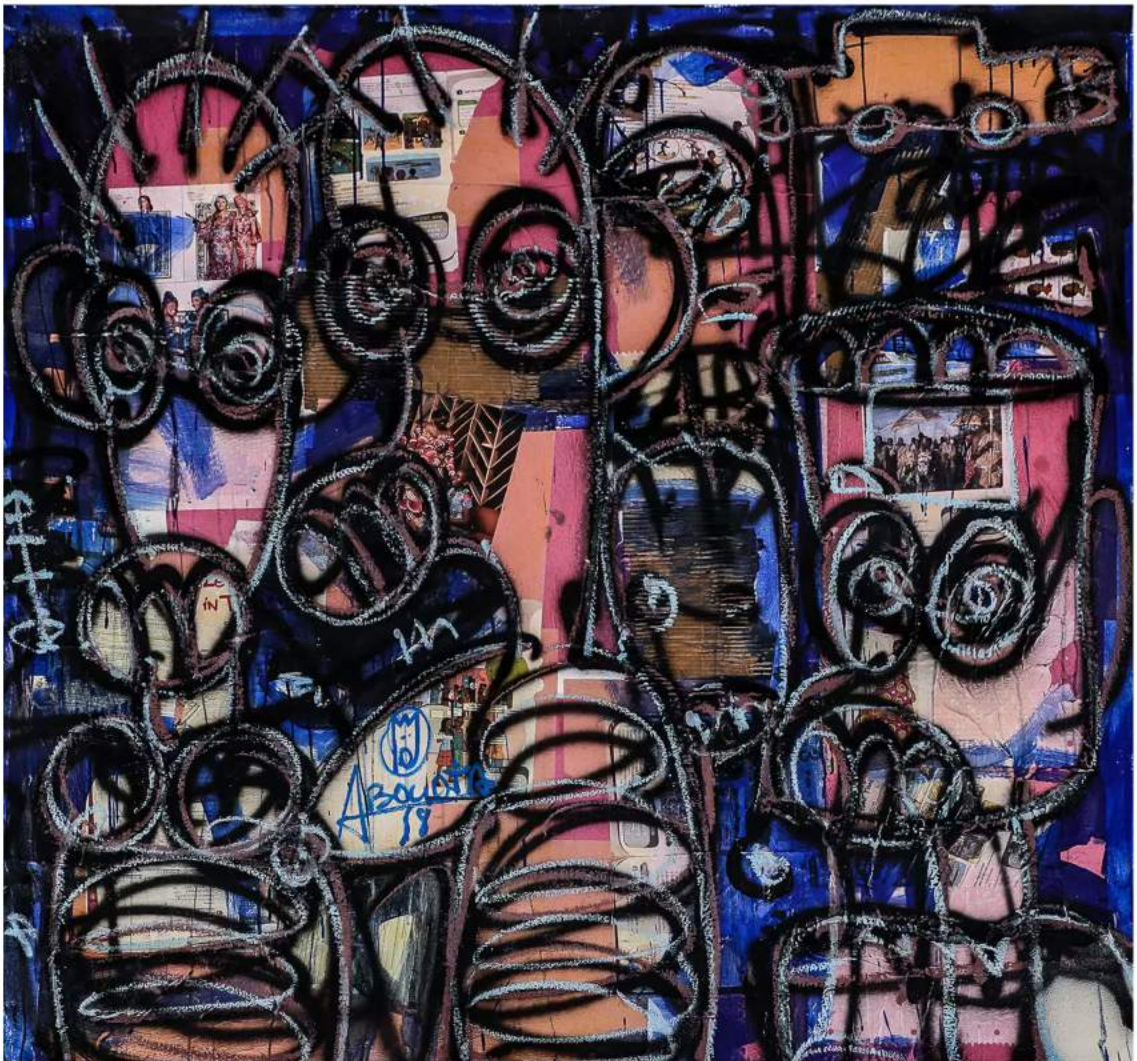

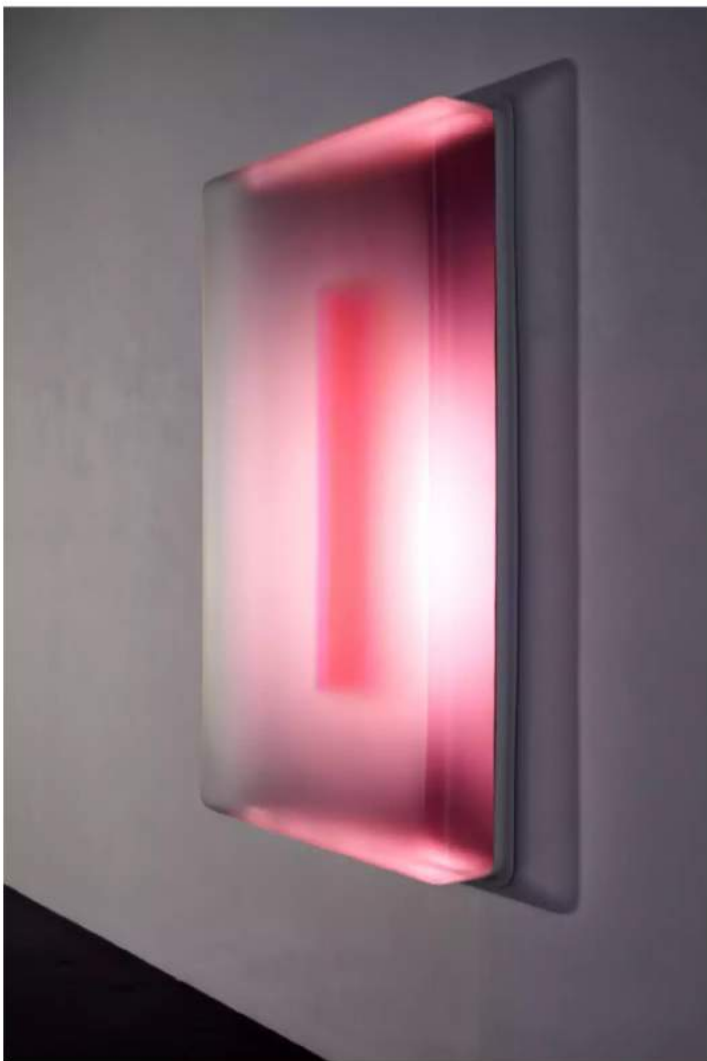

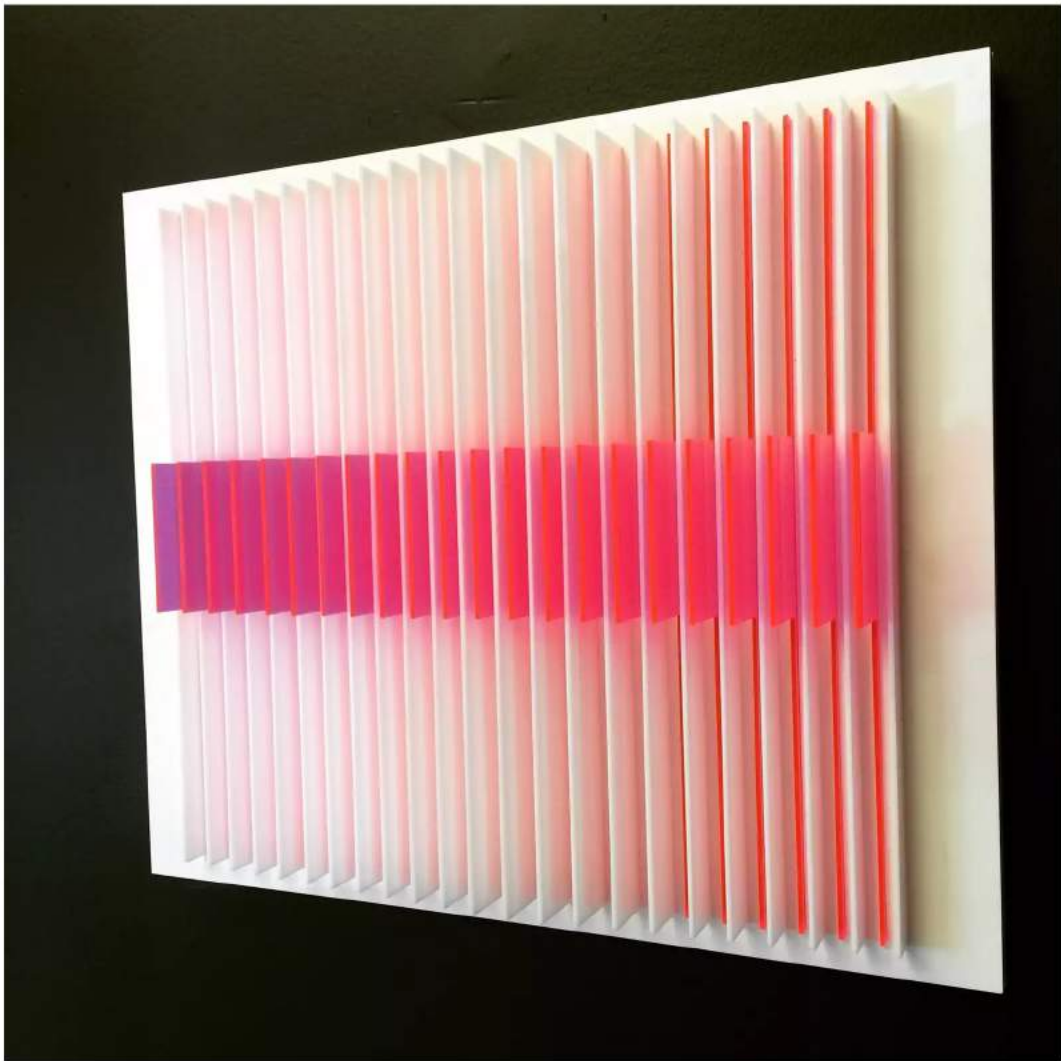
